my Household Furniture, goods, and Effects, during the term
of her natural life, and from and after her decease, I give and
bequeath the said Household Furniture, goods and Effects, to be
equally divided amongst all and every my Children, if any
of my Children should die before that time, or before they or
any of them can make a claim, or demand of the same, and have
Child or Children by their first Marriage, such Child or Children
to have the Parents share equally divided amongst them. Also
I have a certain sum of Money out at Interest, The Interest arising
therefrom I give and bequeath, Will and direct, shall be paid
Annually as the same becometh due to my said beloved Wife
during the term of her natural life, and from and after her
decease I give and bequeath the Principal sum to all and
every of my Children to be equally divided amongst them
if any of my Children should die before that time or before
they or any of them can make a claim or demand of the same,
and have a Child or Children by their first Marriage, such
Child or Children to have the Parents share equally divided
amongst him, her, or them, no Children by any subsequent
Marriage to have any claim or demand thereof. All the rest
